#### **Sickert Says**

State SIR is launching the SIR Vaccine Assistance Team, a program to assist SIR members get their Covid-19 vaccination. I have, and I know others have, had difficulty in knowing where vaccines are available, in making the re-

quired appointment, and in receiving the vaccine. This program is designed to help. In brief, if a member requests assistance in locating a vaccination resource their request will be relayed to the branch where that person is a member. The branch will then contact the member and provide assistance as required.

For Branch 69, Little Sir Mark Steffens has volunteered to coordinate with the callers in following up with members. By the time you read this, you should have been contacted by State SIR at least once. If for some reason you have not, please contact me or Mark and we will get you involved with the team. The hope of this program in getting Branch 69 members vaccinated is that it is all a step closer to the branch more fully reopening and returning to in-person indoor activities.

State SIR has conditionally authorized branches to resume in-person outdoor activities. The condition is that before an activity can begin, the Branch Executive Committee (BEC) for a branch must agree to the provisions of a protocol provided by State SIR that will control how an outdoor activity will be conducted. At this time, the branch has two regular outdoor activities, golf and the annual picnic.

At its February 11 meeting, the Branch BEC approved and adopted the State SIR golf protocol as the protocol for all Branch 69 golf. This is important because this means that our golf events are now covered by State SIR liability insurance. As a result, Lennie and Greg have now begun scheduling official Branch 69 golf outings for March and thereafter.

Our other outdoor branch activity is the Annual Picnic. The State SIR has also provided a model protocol that can be used for this activity as well. We are on our way. Thank you.
